- Madrid walking tour & Team Banquet

Cost of Mission Trip (estimate)

- \$2200 per person – two persons per hotel room
- \$2700 per person – one person per hotel room
- Breakdown
 - Air fare: \$1100
 - Travel Insurance: \$50
 - In country transportation: \$150
 - Zaragoza and Madrid walking tours: \$50
 - Hotel: \$1000 (per room for 8 nights)
 - Group meals: \$250 (5 breakfasts, 5 lunches, 6 dinners)
 - Host expenses: \$100

First Timer Scholarship

Is this your first time going on a mission?

\$500 SCHOLARSHIP

Reduced Cost

\$1700 per person – two persons per hotel room

\$2200 per person – one person per hotel room

Personal Spendings (not included in Mission)

- Meals during free times (2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners, snacks)
- Local transportation during free times (Uber, metro)
- Admission fees and/or tour guides to sites or museums during free times
- Souvenirs
- Others

** Most restaurants and businesses accept credit cards. But you will need some cash (Euros) for small purchases and tips.

- 5/24 Deposit \$300 due (non-refundable)
- 6/14 Team meeting #1

- 9/4 Second payment \$1000 due (non-refundable)

- 10/18 Team meeting #4 (final)
- 10/22 Depart for Spain
- 11/1 Arrive back in Detroit (12:30am)

Next Steps for 2026 Spain Mission

- Indicate your decision by 5/17
- Turn in \$300 deposit by 5/24
- Get Passport (regular 8 weeks / expedited 3 weeks)
 - Existing passport expiration must be later than 6 months after the trip
 - Provide a copy of your passport picture page to John Ho
- Exercise !!!
- Learn as much Spanish as you can
- Attend team meetings for prayer and team building

Q & A

Do I need special immunization?

Traveling to Spain requires no special immunization (may need tetanus booster)

Can I extend the trip for personal travel?

Yes. You can stay longer but there are restrictions. Please coordinate with John Ho

Is the mission trip cost tax deductible?

Yes, but there are some rules that must be followed.

Can I raise financial support for the mission trip cost?

Yes, we encourage you to recruit a team for both prayer and financial support.
